A thought from Pastor Dave...

Many of us here at OCC are enjoying a positive season in our lives, at present. Others are struggling. They may have been sitting next to us last Sunday. Did we notice? Are we praying for one another? I hope so.

It is reassuring to know that we have someone consistently praying for us. I know of at least two people who pray for me often, if not daily. And I appreciate that. I pray that you too, know of ones who are consistently praying for you. Did you know that there is someone far greater than your mum or dad, your pastors, your elders, your Sunday School teacher, your Youth Group leader, or your friend, who is consistently praying for <u>you</u>?

Hebrews 7:25 says, "Therefore he is able, once and forever, to save those who come to God through him. <u>He lives</u> forever to intercede with God on their behalf."

Notice the final sentence. Jesus, God's Son 'intercedes' or 'prays fervently' for all those who come to God through Him.

In the book of Hebrews, it also says that Jesus is the One who can save us from the consequences of our sinful choices. "He is able, once and forever, to save those who come to God through him," and it also says that "He lives forever to intercede with God on their behalf." Interceding means that Jesus is appealing to God, in prayer, on behalf of His followers – us!

You might have been fortunate enough as a child to have seen and heard your mum or dad on their knees praying for you consistently. Imagine walking down your hallway in the middle of the night and seeing and hearing Jesus, the Son of God, on His knees in prayer, on your behalf. Wow! Well don't imagine it, <u>KNOW IT</u>! For that is what he is doing.

The Scottish minister Robert Murray M'Cheyne wrote: "If I could hear Christ praying for me in the next room, I would not fear a million enemies. Yet distance makes no difference. He **IS** praying for me."

If life is a struggle for you at the moment; if you are facing bereavement, loneliness, ill health, a scary event, financial issues, family issues - all these things that make life hard, KNOW this – Jesus is in the next room, just down the hallway, praying for you.
